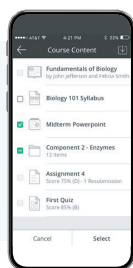

A better learning experience

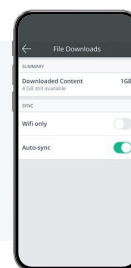
- **Increased availability:** Access content 24x7, regardless of connectivity
